



Fall is For Planting

Keep it simple! This idea had to come from a nursery somewhere! The essence of fall planting is simplicity.

- 1 Dig the hole.
- 2 Place the tree in the hole.
- 3 Backfill and water.

That was easy! Do not forget to water one more time around Halloween.

Because plants do not transpire much after they lose their leaves, and they put lots of energy into making roots, Fall is a great time to plant. Minimal care and few losses make a strong argument for planting in September or October. Please do not forget to keep an eye on the watering in the hot dry summer months, on all your plants.

Very often plants go on sale in the fall as well. How's that for a bonus?
